MENTAL CAPACITY ACT 2008

MENTAL CAPACITY (PUBLIC GUARDIAN FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2026

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 31(3) and (4) of the Mental Capacity Act 2008, the Minister for Social and Family Development makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Mental Capacity (Public Guardian Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2026 and come into operation on 1 May 2026.

Amendment of Schedule

2. In the Mental Capacity (Public Guardian Fees) Regulations 2010 (G.N. No. S 106/2010), in the Schedule —

- (a) in item 1(b), in the second column, replace “\$185” with “\$30”; and
- (b) replace items 2 and 3 with —
