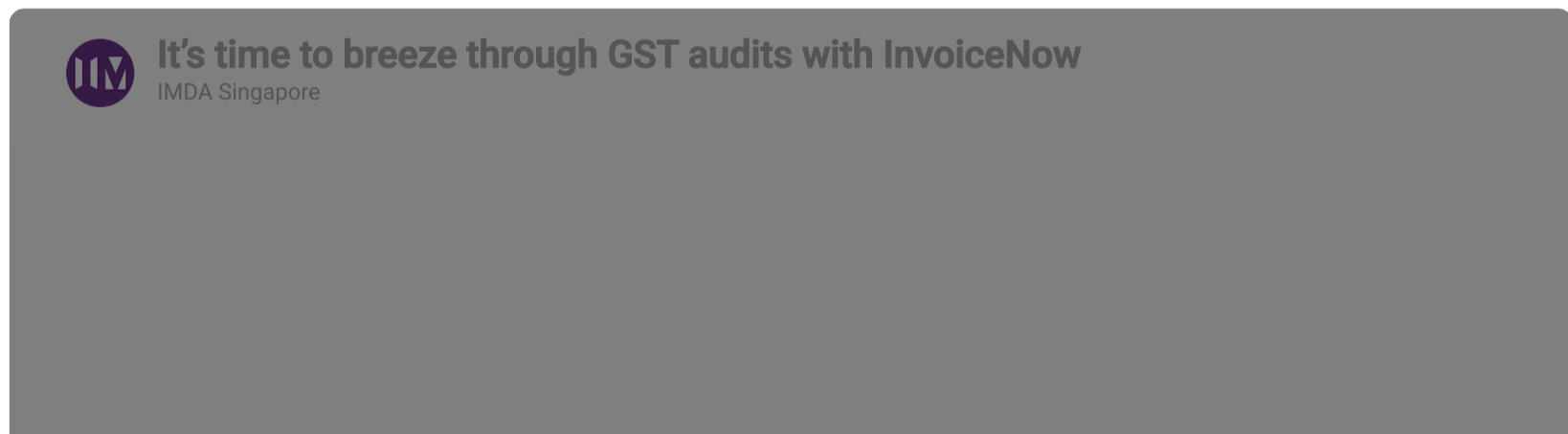

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
GST InvoiceNow Requirement



To support the nationwide InvoiceNow initiative and digitalise tax administration, GST-registered businesses will be required to submit invoice data directly to IRAS via the InvoiceNow network. This will be mandated in phases.

Roadmap for the GST InvoiceNow Requirement

GST-registered businesses will be required to onboard InvoiceNow and submit invoice data directly to IRAS via the InvoiceNow network. This will be mandated in phases.



IMPLEMENTATION DATE	BUSINESSES INVOLVED
1 November 2025	Companies that register for GST voluntarily within 6 months of incorporation date
1 April 2026	All new voluntary GST registrants, regardless of their incorporation date or business structure
1 April 2028	All new compulsory GST registrants Existing GST-registered businesses with total annual supplies* ≤ S\$200,000
1 April 2029	Existing GST-registered businesses with total annual supplies* ≤ S\$1,000,000
1 April 2030	Existing GST-registered businesses with total annual supplies* ≤ S\$4,000,000
1 April 2031	Existing GST-registered businesses with total annual supplies* > S\$4,000,000

*Total annual supplies refer to the total value of standard-rated, zero-rated and exempt supplies made in all the prescribed accounting periods ending in calendar year 2025.

InvoiceNow for government vendors

About 50% of government vendors are now registered on the nationwide e-invoicing network, InvoiceNow. The Government will implement InvoiceNow as the default e-invoice submission channel for all Government vendors who are registered businesses within the next few years and will eventually replace the Vendors@Gov portal for this group of vendors. We strongly urge vendors who are onboard the network to start sending e-invoices through this channel and those who yet to come onboard to do so as soon as possible.
